



Token Transit

Token Transit* lets riders buy bus passes on their smart phone and send bus passes to a phone number on the Token Transit website. One-way passes and 31-Day passes, both general fare and reduced fare, for all Kern Transit routes are available. Please have your Reduced Fare Card and your pass ready to show the bus driver when boarding if a reduced fare pass has been purchased.



Dial-A-Ride is a reservation-based, curb-to-curb service. Service is available to the general public on a first-come, first-served basis.

SCHEDULING

Scheduling times are subject to the Dial-A-Ride hours in each community. Reservations must be made at least one day in advance and can be made up to two weeks in advance. Day-of reservations are based on availability.
