SCHEDULE CHANGES

New schedules for Kern Transit will go into effect on **Sunday, December 24, 2023.**

Affected Fixed Routes - 100, 130, 150, 220, and 250.

Route 100 has been updated to help improve connections with Metrolink's most recent schedule changes in Lancaster.

Route 130 has experienced changes as well to provide more time for commuting passengers and riders utilizing the Dial-A-Ride in the Frazier Park area.

Due to service reductions in Route 220, adjustments have been made to Route 150 as well.

Lastly, slight adjustments have been made to Route 250 to help reduce layover for students attending Antelope Valley College.

DIAL-A-RIDE

For individuals who may not be able to drive, who may not have a personal vehicle, or who may have disabilities, Dial-A-Ride can be an option to meet transportation needs such as grocery shopping, medical appointments, regular commutes to work, and social activities in and around town.

Much like Uber and Lyft services, Dial-A-Ride has the ability to work within a desired timeframe requested by the rider and provides a more cost-effective option than taxi services.
