WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY

Winter weather is here. As individuals travel throughout Kern County, the need to plan ahead cannot be stressed enough. Colder weather can cause hazardous road conditions and may require a sudden change in transit service including potential delays as well as cancellations.

For safety concerns, Kern Transit cannot provide service beyond a "Chains Required" sign or when the road conditions become too icy.

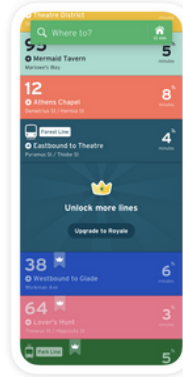
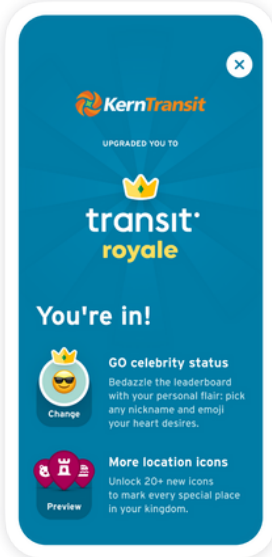


Kern Transit has partnered with the **Transit app** to offer all of our riders access to their paid subscription service - **Transit Royale** completely free of cost.

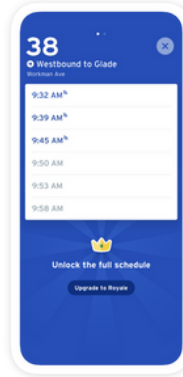
